The washing machines are needed urgently as the old ones are completely broken down.

They are having to hand wash everything for 50+ kids including bedding etc.

Also because of the rain things don't dry properly and very often the kids are putting on damp clothes.

Pat considers the washing machines and the mosquito nets are the most important items at the moment and would be blessed to receive the finances to purchase them.

None of the girls have mosquito nets and have to sleep with their heads under the blankets to avoid the mosquitos.

With the college fees being so high this term they cannot even afford to buy just a few.
