

Who is going to Kuffu this year, and when are you going?

We will be going to Kuffu on the 10<sup>th</sup> July and return on the 20<sup>th</sup> July this year there are 11 people going from 4 churches from Brandon Church Ken, Val and Jason. From Mildenhall Church Bishop Vally and three others (names unknown). From Thetford Church Stu and finally from Grace Community Church Andrew, Susan and Linda.

What will the travel to Kuffu be like, and what's your accommodation while you're there?

We will be flying from Heathrow, with one stop at Dubai then on to Entebbe we will be collected by minibus and taken to Kampala. Our accommodation will be a Christian guesthouse.

What's the weather likely to be like-is it very hot? What about the food? What are the likely changes since you was last there?

The weather will be hot with possible downpours. The main food eaten by us will be rice, beans, potatoes and matooke (green banana) these are staple food crops of Uganda. The main changes we will see, will be the start of the medical centre, and the construction of the CCL classrooms, these classrooms are for young girls who left education due to having babies. So they are now given the opportunity to continue with education and gain practical skills, these classrooms are sponsored by Jaja Ann.

Tell us please, about some of the people you're particularly looking forward to meeting again?

We are looking forward to seeing Pastor Samuel and his family and Alex and his family, whom we helped with finances when his wife was due to have their first baby so she was able to give birth in a hospital.

What stage do you think the new clinic building (that we are supporting) will be at? Is there a completion date?

We are hopeful that the building will be up to roof height, unsure as to a completion date.

Do you work at all while you are there? Preaching, teaching, serving food or cleaning up?

Yes we will all serve in different capacities. Andrew, Ken, Val and Bishop Vally will preach and teach. Linda and Susan will work with children and young adults in the CCL classrooms. Others will help with various practical jobs on site.

What are the risks, the things that you worry about-can we pray for these?

We take as many practical precautions as possible for health by having injections against various diseases but would appreciate prayer for health and wellbeing. Please also pray for general safety when travelling.
